She will go into the park five days per week from 2pm-6pm to observe elephants using an app to record their behavior. Brooke is escorted by rangers on a regular basis and will need assistance in communication with the rangers during that time. Assistance with this research will provide emerging conservationists and students in learning how to conduct field-based wildlife behavioral research and elephant conservation research.

Responsibilities: You will actively participate in field research five days a week from 2pm - 6pm that involves searching for wild elephants and monitoring elephant behavior and taking photos of elephants. You will also assist with other responsibilities from 10am to 2pm that will include administrative responsibilities and data work.

- Track and identify wild elephants.
- Record elephant behavior
- Assist with english and thai translation
- Contribute to elephant identification
- Data entry and cleaning
- Other tasks to support research (reports, correspondence, social media etc.)
